Reconstructive surgery options include local tissue rearrangement with flaps, and skin grafts. If muscle, bone or cartilage is removed during surgery, these tissues will also be reconstructed to achieve balance and symmetry.

Scalp reconstruction is a surgical procedure for people with scalp defects. Scalp defects may be partial or full thickness and can be congenital or acquired. Because not all layers of the scalp are elastic and the scalp has a convex shape, the use of primary closure is limited. Sometimes the easiest way of closing the wound may not be the ideal or best way.
