In mood, marches range from the moving death march in Wagner's *Götterdämmerung* to the brisk military marches of John Philip Sousa and the martial hymns of the late 19th century.

Cadence has come to mean "the rhythm of sounds" from its root *cadere* which means "to fall." Originally designating falling tones especially at the end of lines of music or poetry, cadence broadened to mean the rhythms of the tones and sometimes even the rhythm of sounds in general. Think of the cadence of the marching band at a football game or the cadence of the crickets on a warm spring night.
