Marlene Dietrich was a German-American actress.. In the 1920s, she acted on the Berlin stage and in silent films, making her film debut in 1922. She was propelled to international fame by director Josef von Sternberg, who cast her as Lola-Lola in *The Blue Angel* (1930). The film's commercial success brought her a contract with Paramount Pictures in the United States.
